Official Course Description:

Selected topics in the field, such as the processes of growth in urban systems or urban ecology.

Prerequisite:

Geography 351 and 451 or consent of the Department. It is not necessary to pass all parts of the course to obtain a passing final grade.

Course Description

A critical survey of the regulatory literature on urban system development processes, focusing on the government strategies for regulating and controlling urban growth. The course will deal with the reasons for and against regulation and will then focus on specific population, settlement, land use, regional, and economic development strategies used by governments to stimulate or reduce the growth of cities. It will also discuss the effectiveness of these measures. The focus of the course is world-wide but will also use some Canadian examples when relevant.

Grading:

Mid Term: 20%. Date to be arranged by discussion with students

Take home-Final: 50% (No scheduled Registrar's exam)

Given out in last 2 weeks of term (dates with student agreement) with 2 weeks to complete.

(Three or four essays: maximum 5 sides of text per answer at c.30lines/page).

<u>Projects and Assignments</u> 30% (Maximum of two papers)

The final grade is based on all the work completed. Students do not have to pass any one part of the course in order to pass the course as a whole.
